

An Interview with NZYMES.COM

The following interview was conducted in January 2001 by Rhonda Wiseberg of "THEPETFILES.COM for a online radio edition of "THEPETPROJECT.COM"

Hi! For those of you that have been listening to The Pet Files, you know that I have an avid interest in pet health and good nutrition, so I'm very excited to have a chance to talk with Stan Stansbury, Vice President of Biopet Inc. about one of their products **Nzymes Antioxidant Treats**.

Rhonda: How are you Stan?

Stan: I am doing very well, thank You!

Rhonda: I guess the first thing that strikes me about **Nzymes** through all of the many testimonials I have read, is that it seems to help so many different problems. Everything from arthritis to epilepsy. On the one hand **Nzymes** seems like a miracle cure. On the other, it suggests to me that this product is supplying some fundamental physiological need that our pets are lacking.

Stan: I think that statement hits the nail right on the head Rhonda. Never in the history of man has the old saying "you are what you eat," meant more to all living things on this planet. Each day our phone rings from customers who have pets' with problems – the scary fact is that most of those problems can be directly related to deficiencies caused by the foods they are fed over their lifetime. Today, even the best commercial pet foods have their natural enzymes destroyed through processing.

The basics are this. When food is heated, boiled, steamed or processed above 118 degrees, the enzymes are destroyed. A handful of better pet food companies have done an excellent job of trying to reintroduce what is missing in a processed diet, but none to date have addressed this vital need for dietary enzymes.

This is why our **Nzymes** supplement is so critical to pet's diets and for maintaining sustained health. Remember; the body always tries to heal itself provided it gets the "Right tools"!

Stan: Dr. Pottenger's study not only demonstrated the types of chronic diseases that develop from a diet of processed foods but went on to show that these degenerative problems would increase in successive generations who continued eating processed foods.

From my reading of his multi-generation study, I felt, he was saying that the DNA and chromosome structure in these test animals became damaged, then this damage was passed forward to the newer generations when the animals reproduced.

That's why we feel it's so important to at least give your pet a quality whole food supplement everyday. Our Nzymes product has demonstrated it's ability to help cleanse toxins and dangerous free radicals from a pet's body and at the same time restore the normal healthy functioning of the immune system.

Rhonda: What exactly are **Nzymes**? And what ingredients are in your product?

First, because of our product name (Nzymes), many people think of it as a digestive enzyme, this is not correct. Though Nzymes contributes greatly to digestion, our product is primarily a whole food supplement, which is live with natural food enzymes. It's our special blend of super nutritional sprouted soy protein and RiceX ricebran, which is used by the body to manufacture complete series important metabolic enzymes.

In addition, this whole food blend works effectively to help the body with digestion by naturally increasing the body's production of digestive enzymes like amylase, lipase and protease, which help to increase the absorption of nutrients from the other food sources.

These processes focus towards strengthening and balancing the immune system, which is important for every body function. That is why **Nzymes** is used so effectively for so many different problems.

Rhonda: Should we start feeding **Nzymes** to younger pets? Or is this product more helpful for older animals. Is it something we will want to add to their diets their entire life? It's certainly priced reasonably enough to do that.

Stan: Well, Rhonda, the answer is every pet, young or old, needs **Nzymes** everyday of their lives to help balance the effects of processed and cooked foods.

We are very fortunate to get the chance to work with some wonderful pet nutritionists around the country like Linda Arndt (www.greatdanelady.com). She has used this formula in her own breeding program for over 15 years with great success. She recommends starting puppies on the **Nzymes** formula at 5 weeks of age and continuing a maintenance dosage throughout the life of all her animals.

It is very important to double the usage when young animals are vaccinated or spayed as it help with the healing process and to cleanse toxins involved in those procedures.

Even though **Nzymes** great for young growing animals our greatest success stories come from animals which have grown older and feel the effects of aging. Problems like arthritis, hip dysplasia, joint pain, and inflammation. All these seem to show remarkable improvement in a very short time. Rhonda: What form does it come in? Is it pretty easy to get into our animals?

Stan: **Nzymes** are available in two forms; **Nzymes Antioxidant Treats** and our basic formula, **Nzymes Granules**. The treats are small chewable tablets which are liver and beef flavored. Most dogs and cats love them. Believe me, they will let you know its **NZYMES** time. For finicky pets we suggest to crumble the treat or use the Granules and mix it with their normal food. For Cats, we have found that mixing the **Nzymes** treat with a small amount of tuna is the perfect solution.

Rhonda: Are **Nzymes** something we need a veterinary prescription for? And can we use it along with other prescription or herbal medications?

Stan: Because **Nzymes** are a "whole food" they do not conflict with any medications or herbal remedies. That is another benefit. It enhances the body's ability to heal by providing the system with the elements needed to make repairs.

Rhonda: How soon should we see results?

Stan: We guarantee people will see a significant change in their pets within 30 days, however, most of our customers tell us they notice a difference in as short as 4 to 10 days.
