2 Simple Steps Nzymes Respiratory Program

Step #1 Ox-E-Drops

Mix the correct amount of the Nzymes Ox-E-Drops with distilled or filtered water in the included oral syringe.



Disp	pense along teeth line.

WeightAmount to Give 3 Times DailyDogs 3-12 lbs.2 drops with 1/2 tsp waterDogs 13-25 lbs.3 drops with 1 tsp waterDogs 26-50 lbs.4 drops with 1 tsp waterDogs 51-100 lbs.5 drops with 1 tsp waterDogs 101-200 lbs.7 drops with 1.5 tsp water

Dispense Along Teeth Line To avoid possible choaking squirt the mixture close along the pet's teeth-line and allow the pet to lick it up and swallow it slowly.

Do this 3 times per day!





Add one (1) teaspoon of the Nzymes Ox-E-Drops to the water in a 1 gallon vaporizer. Place it about 10 to 15 inches directly in front of the kennel for the pet to breath.

Put the dog in the kennel and cover the kennel with sheet.

Vaporize the dog for 15 minutes each hour and repeat the process each hour for 4 hours. Do this every day until symptoms subside. Following the guidelines above, you should see a noticeable difference in your dog's breathing within 3-4 days.


NOTE:

If you do not have a pet carrier, you can use a small inclosed area, like a small bathroom. In which case we suggest to increase the vaporizer time to 25 minutes.



2 Simple Steps: Step #2 Antioxidant Treats

Each day give your dog the amount of the Antioxidant Treats suggested below based on weight as nutritional support during respiratory recovery.



Weight	Amount to Give
Dogs 3-12 lbs	1 treat per day
Dogs 13-25 lbs	2 treats per day
Dogs 26-50 lbs	2 treats per day
Dogs 51-100 lbs	4 treats per day
Dogs 101-200 lbs	4 treats per day
